For Students with ADD/ADHD

___ Your last IEP or 504 Plan (if you had one in school)

___ ADD/ADHD Form (available on our website)

___ Registration Form (Log into the AIM portal using your Longwood credentials)

For Students with Medical or Psychological Disabilities

___ Your last IEP or 504 Plan (if you had one in school)

___ Verification of Disability Form (available on our website)

___ Registration Form (Log into the AIM portal using your Longwood credentials)

___ Check our Website for Information About Disability Related Housing Requests

___ Submit all the Important Documents Listed Above That Pertain to Your Disability in the AIM portal

___ We will contact you via your Longwood email to schedule an appointment with one of our professional staff to discuss possible academic accommodations

___ Go To Your Scheduled Appointment and Meet Everyone in the Office

___ Gather Additional Documentation (if needed)

___ Meet With Your Professors Once You Have Your Accommodation Letters
