Earn your Administration and Supervision PreK-12 Endorsement - Upon successful completion of program coursework, passing scores on the School Leaders Licensure Assessment (SLLA), and fulfillment of Virginia Department of Education's three-year teaching requirement, candidates will be prepared and endorsed to serve as educational leaders in today's schools and school divisions.

### PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

Designed for teachers who hold a valid Virginia Collegiate Professional License or equivalent from another state and wish to pursue a career in school administration. Students are prepared for administrative, supervisory, and leadership roles in today's public and private schools, school divisions, and educational organizations.

This five-semester, hybrid master's program is designed with the working professional in mind, providing students with real-world, authentic learning in educational leadership. Through the program, you will learn to:

### CAPSTONE

- ✓ 2.75 undergrad GPA\* (on 4.0 scale)

- ✓ Personal Essay (500 words or less)
